

AMBA Membership Policy

Eligibility

To be eligible for AMBA student or graduate membership, you must have enrolled on your University or business school course at the time the programme was accredited. If you are unsure of whether your programme was accredited at the time, please contact the membership team who can assist you directly.

Registration

To register for your free account, please head to our <u>registration page</u> to initiate the process. If you're a current student, please use your university or business school email address. If you have already graduated and do not possess a university or business school email address, please contact the <u>membership team</u>.

To speed the registration process up, please provide your official transcript, including your date of enrolment and graduation.

Certificates

As a member who's graduated from an accredited AMBA programme, you will have the opportunity to purchase a blockchain-secured certificate. Please note that an official transcript with the final grade is required. In the event that you fail to provide the evidence of a successful graduation, AMBA will refund the payment for the certificate.

Cancellation

If you'd like to close your account, you can do so at anytime by contacting the <u>membership team</u>. Please note that this will erase all your data with AMBA. All requests are usually handled within seven business days.

Termination of account

AMBA reserves the right to terminate your account without notice should you be in direct violation of the terms of service.
