



SPECIAL UPDATE: AMBA ACCREDITATION ELIGIBILITY

In 2018 AMBA imposed a 300 cap limit on the total number of accredited AMBA business schools. We are pleased to announce that with effect from January 2026, we will remove this cap, such that a few more high-quality, eligible business schools will be able to apply for potential AMBA accreditation.

We have taken this decision to reflect the continuous improvement in quality standards of potential candidate business schools, allowing more who are able to meet our rigorous accreditation quality standards to benefit from the impact and inclusivity of AMBA accreditation.

To be eligible to register for AMBA accreditation, preference will be given to business schools who meet one or more of the following:

1. Business schools who are already double accredited AACSB + EQUIS
2. Business schools who are already double accredited BGA + AACSB or EQUIS
3. The best quality business schools from countries where the global AMBA network is under-represented

Business schools who are eligible may then progress to registration.

Please note that eligibility is no guarantee of AMBA accreditation.
